The UNIVERSITY PHOTOGRAPHERS ASSOCIATION is a professional association in which college and university photographers form a partnership for the fostering and furtherance of photographic techniques as a result of interchange of thoughts and opinions among its members.

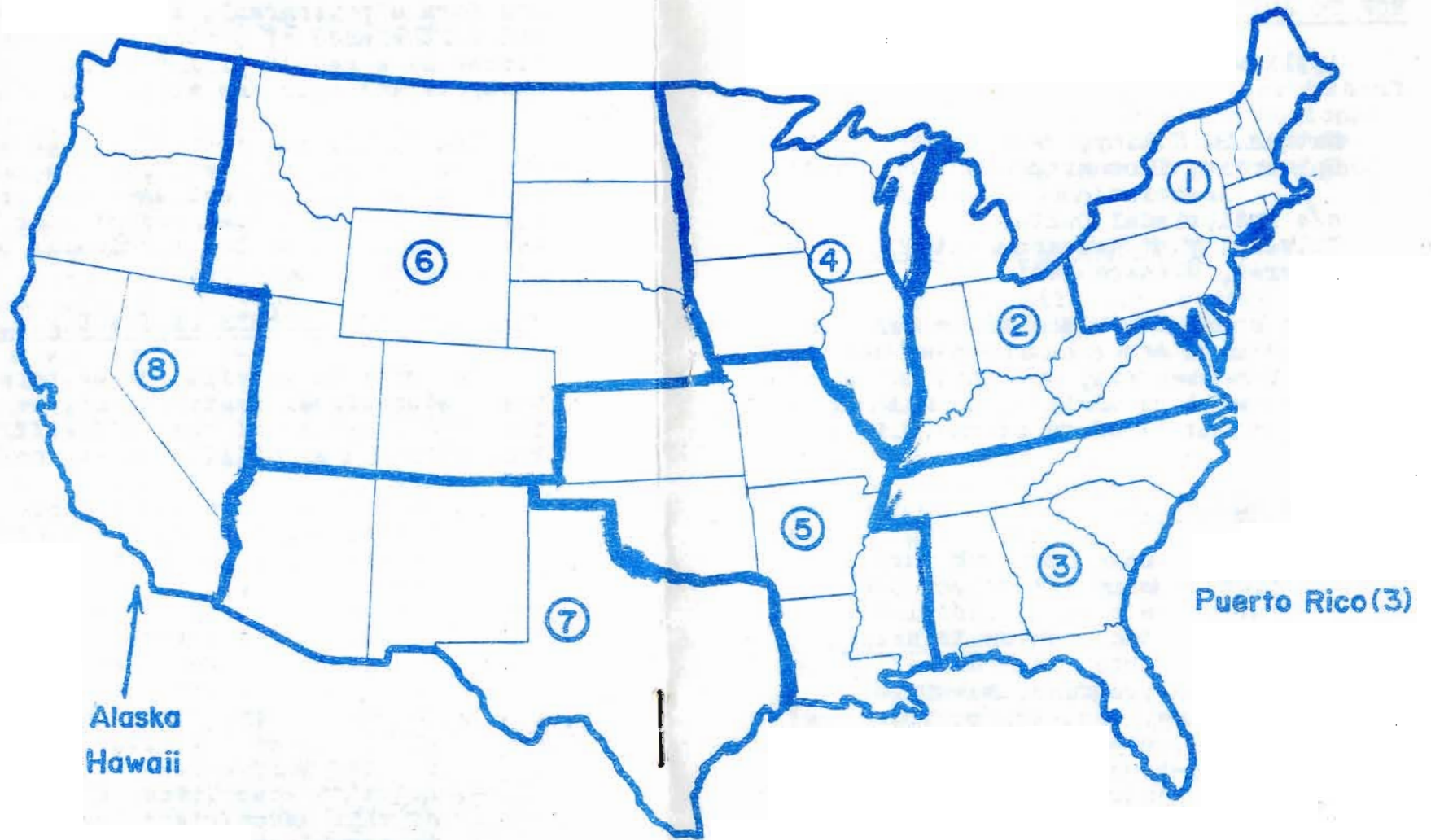
The U.P.A. was founded in December, 1961 by a group of photographers from various New England colleges and universities. They felt the need of such an association due to the particular nature of university photography.

WHAT ARE THE PURPOSES OF THE U.P.A.?

In order to benefit our members and their educational institutions, we feel that the purposes of the UNIVERSITY PHOTOGRAPHERS ASSOCIATION must include the following:

1. Further and develop the potentialities of the photographic arts in improving instruction and communication.
2. Foster and further photographic techniques as a result of interchange of thoughts and opinions among its members.
3. Cooperate with other organizations which may be striving to accomplish similar purposes.
4. Acquaint educational institutions of this Association in an effort to establish confidence in, and good will for the Association members.

REGIONAL ACTIVITY

In order to make our work throughout the country more effective, the United States has been divided into 8 U.P.A. regions. Each region is headed and guided by elected regional officers. Thus, the local programs, meetings, seminars, forums, etc. are provided to smaller groups, creating the opportunity to keep up-to-date on technical developments, equipment, U.P.A. activities, job opportunities, laws, etc.

VOTING

Voting is by institution instead of individual membership, each institution having one vote. In this manner, a small college with only one U.P.A. member will have equal voice in the Association with the larger universities having possibly three or four members.

U.P.A. JOURNAL

The U.P.A. JOURNAL endeavors to compile all the news from the regional organizations concerning their activities and disseminates it for the good of all its members.

WHAT CAN U.P.A. DO FOR YOU?

If you are eligible to join the UNIVERSITY PHOTOGRAPHERS ASSOCIATION and decide to become a member, you will be joining with many of your colleagues a Professional Association designed for your interests and benefit. Your college or university will be kept informed of all U.P.A. activities, thus giving you recognition on your own campus, as well as throughout the country. Your national association will render assistance to all regional groups in every possible way.

ANNUAL CONFERENCE

The Annual Conference of the U.P.A. is a culmination of the year's activities and a gain of impetus for the next year. It provides discussion groups, demonstrations and exhibits of members' work, human relations, relaxation, and election of officers - besides the intangible togetherness of members from everywhere.
